

This is an Announcement for Foreign Residents of Saitama City with Children.

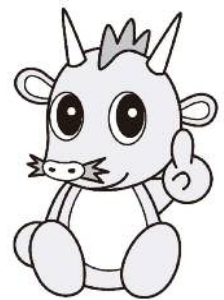


All children of foreign residents living in Saitama City are eligible to enroll in public elementary and junior high schools.

※Including those who are not eligible for a Residence Card or the Certificate of Special Permanent Resident.

◇The conditions are:

- ① The child must be a resident of Saitama City
- ② The child must be of an appropriate age to attend school
- ※ Students considered of appropriate age to attend public schools during the school year from April 2019 until March 2020 are:
Elementary School: Children born between April 2nd, 2007 and April 1st 2013
Junior High School: Children born between April 2nd, 2004 and April 1st 2007



◇To register:

Go to the Ward Community Service Division at your respective ward office to register for a Certificate of Residence and tell them that you want to enroll your child in a public elementary or junior high school.

◆How to register for those who are not eligible for a Certificate of Residence:

- (1) Where: Saitama City Board of Education School Affairs Division
Saitama City Hall 3th floor
Urawa Ward, Tokiwa 6-4-4
- (2) What to Bring: ① Passport
② Something which clearly shows your place of residence (apartment lease etc.)

◇Thing to note:

- ① The school your child attends will be decided by where you live.
- ② The parent/guardian of the child must register him/her at the School Affairs Division.
- ③ Your child will study the same materials as Japanese students.
- ④ There will be no entrance fees or tuition charged.
- ⑤ Students over the eligible ages will not be able to attend school.
